

DECCA'S CHAIRMAN NAMED HONORARY CITIZEN OF DONGGUAN

Mr. Tsang Chi Hung, Chairman of Decca Holdings Limited (stock code: 997), was recently named an Honorary Citizen of Dongguan City.
